

How to play Paper Fortune Teller:

Player A – asks the questions

Player B – replies to player A's questions

Player A: "Choose a color" (Player A should hold the game closed so that player B sees only the four colors.)

Player B: Calls out a color (Ex: "Blue")

Player A: Spell out "Blue", opening the game one way on "B" and the other way on "L", etc. Once completed, ask Player B to choose a number.

Player B: Calls out a number (Ex: "2")

Player A: Count to "2" while opening the game one way on "1" and the other way on "2". Once completed, ask Player B to choose another number.

Player B: Calls out a number (Ex: "1")

Player A: Open the flap with the number 1 on it, and read the text under the flap to reveal Player B's fortune.

Creating a Paper Fortune Teller with an 8 1/2 x 11 piece of paper:

Step 1. Start with an 8 1/2" x 11" piece of paper.

Step 2. Fold one short edge up to one long edge and make a crease.

Step 3. Cut off excess (as shown on diagram) and unfold.

Step 4. You should have a perfect square.

Step 5. Fold each corner to the center

Step 6. Once completed, flip paper over.

Step 7. Fold the new corners to the center.

Step 8. Fold the square in half from edge to edge in both directions.

Step 9. Turn square over and put thumbs and forefingers under each flap and bring fingers together toward middle.
